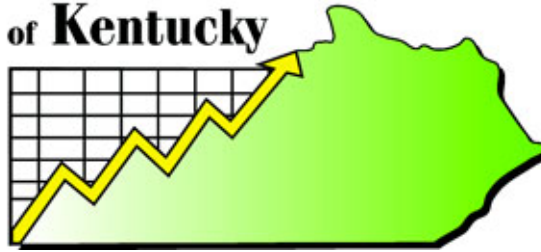

ABAK Agriculture Scholarship Program

The AgriBusiness Association of Kentucky has developed a scholarship program for undergraduate students to help them afford the cost of a postsecondary education.

The scholarship program was established in 1996 to recognize and assist Kentucky students majoring in agriculture. The scholarship is in the amount of \$1,000 per school year paid in two equal installments of \$500 per semester. The scholarship is based on merit as well as financial need.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this scholarship, students must submit the following by the postmark deadline:

- A completed copy of the application form.
- Three required essays.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- Most recent official transcript.

The applicant also must meet the following qualifications:

- (1) Be accepted for enrollment as an undergraduate in a post-secondary institution (public or private college or university, or vocational technical school) for the fall semester of the upcoming school year.
- (2) Be a Kentucky resident.
- (3) Have a declared major in an agricultural related field of study or be accepted into an agricultural study program.
- (4) Past recipients of the ABAK scholarship are NOT eligible.
